

# WALKS CALENDAR AUGUST—DECEMBER 2018



## SUNDAY 26 AUGUST

Together, walks 52 and 14 make up the Society's suggested combination walk G. However, there is no obligation to do both. Please feel free to join the morning walk, the afternoon walk or both as you wish. **Both walks will start from the Crown Point Loop just off the A25 at TN15 0HB (map reference TQ 576557).** The Crown Point Inn is very close to the start and there is a picnic spot and parking available in nearby Styants wood.

### Morning walk Walk 52—Volume 4

Meet in time for a 10:00 start (see above). The walk from Crown Point to Godden Green and Stone Street is 5 miles in length and the going is moderate.

### Afternoon walk Walk 14—Volume 2

Meet in time for a 14:00 start as above. This is not the normal start for this walk. It is actually point 6 on the Sevenoaks Society Map of Walk 14. The walk, which proceeds through Styants Wood to Oldbury Hill and Fish Ponds Wood before returning to Crown Point is 3.5 miles in length and is hilly.

## SUNDAY 30 SEPTEMBER

There will be a morning walk and an afternoon walk both starting from West Peckham. The green at West Peckham is a delightful spot for a picnic and the Swan is conveniently situated for lunchtime refreshment should this be required.

### Morning walk

Meet in time for a prompt 10:00 start from the Swan on the Green pub. The walk will take the form of a southerly loop of around 6 miles of fairly flat walking taking in various points of local interest such as East Peckham church, Roydon Hall, Hadlow Tower and Oxen Hoath.

### Afternoon walk Walk 62—Volume 6

This is a new walk recently introduced by Nick White and forms part of volume 6 of the Society's Walks due to be published in 2018.

Meet at entrance to West Peckham at the junction of Mereworth Road, Church Road and Forge Lane in time for a prompt 14:00 start. The walk heads North West on Stan Lane to Bo-peep Shaw then to Yotes Court, Wold's End Wood, Swanton Valley, and Hurstwood before returning via Rat's Castle and Gover Hill to Oxenhoath, Court Lodge Farm and West Peckham. The walk is 5 miles in length and is moderately hilly.

## SUNDAY 28 OCTOBER

Walk 22 - Volume 2.

Meet on Westerham Green near the statue of Winston Churchill (map reference TQ 447540) in time for a prompt 14:00 start. The walk takes a Southerly route via Hosey Common, Chartwell and Froghole before returning via Crockhamhill Common and Squerryes. This walk is 5.5 miles in length and hilly.

## SUNDAY 25 NOVEMBER

Walk 56—Volume 6.

Meet at public car park in Cudham, 50m south of Blacksmith's Arms TN14 7QB (map reference TQ446597) in time for a prompt 14:00 start. The walk heads north east to Mace Farm and Norstead Manor Farm before returning south via The Washneys and Newlands Wood to Birches Croft and Cacket's Farm back to Cudham. This walk is just under 5 miles in length and pleasantly undulating rather than hilly. It can be muddy in parts and dogs, although welcome on walks, may have difficulty with some stiles.
